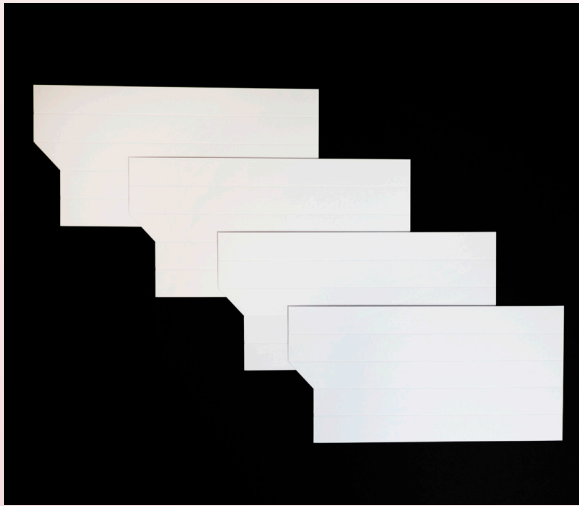
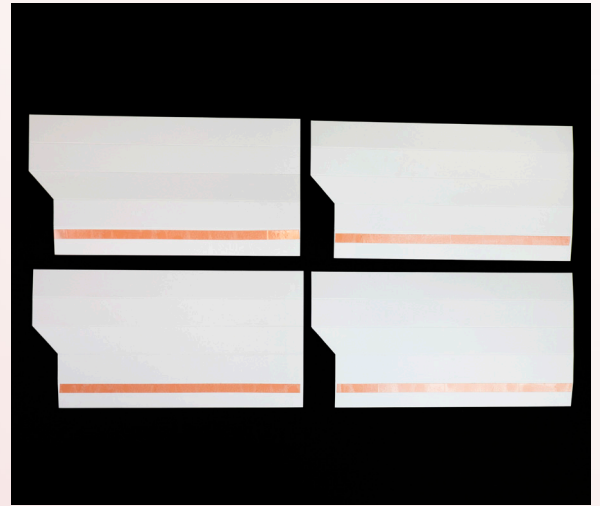


The frame in these instruction is an 11 inch square. The pieces can be trimmed down to create other sized frames.

How to build the 3D frames



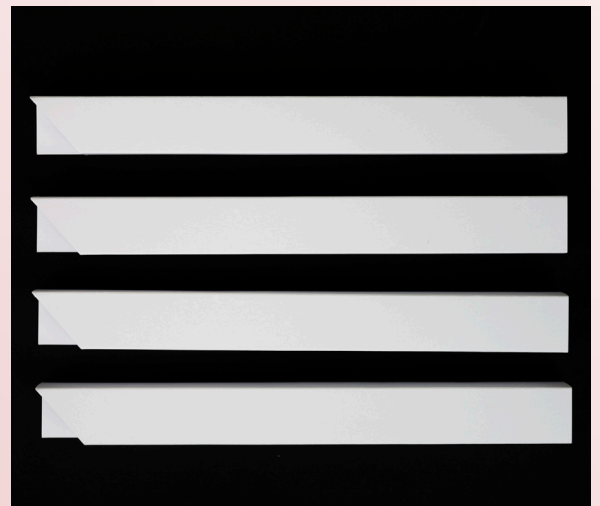
1. For this project sheet we are working with the 1 inch wide frames. When working with the frame pieces, you can work with them either way just make sure you keep each piece facing the same way as you work.



2. Fold along the score lines of each piece. Run red liner tape along the bottom fold of each piece just under the score line. Make sure to leave 1-2mm of space between the tape and the score line. You can also use wet glue but you would have to wait for it to dry before moving on.

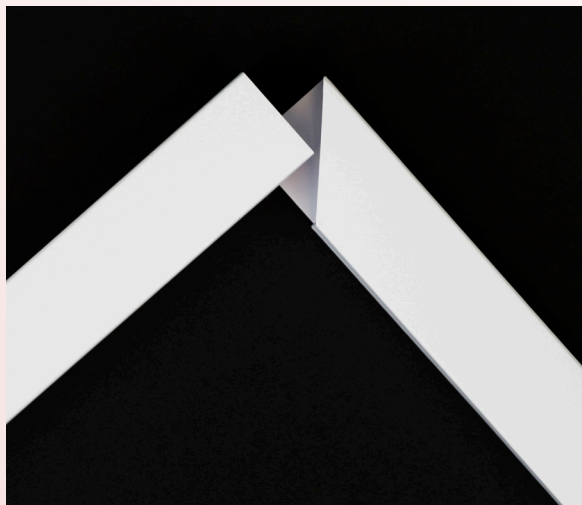


3. Fold up one of the pieces so the bottom fold with the red liner tape sits under the top fold and stick.

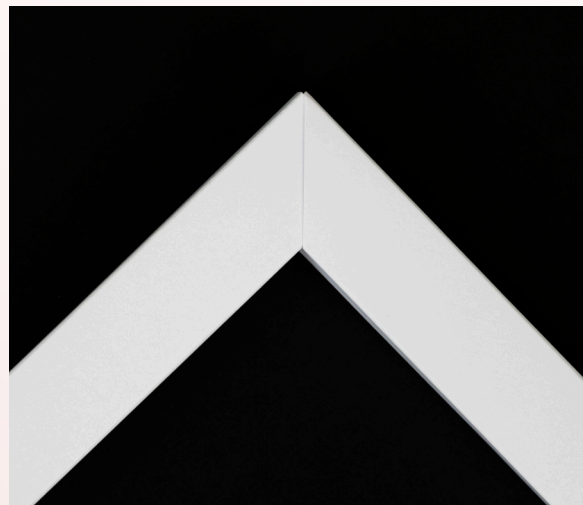


4. Repeat Step 3 with the three remaining pieces until you have all four frame sides.

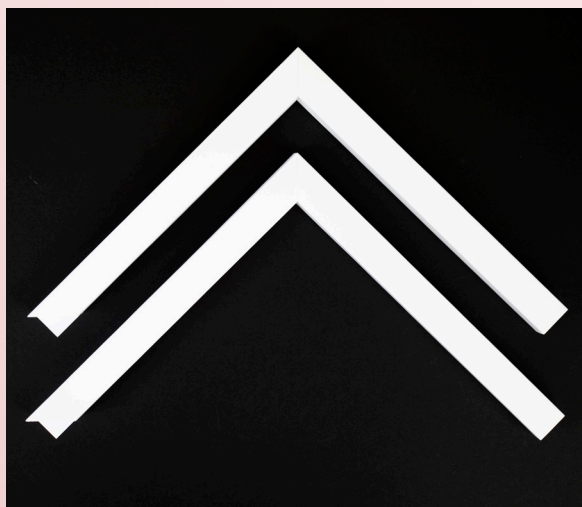
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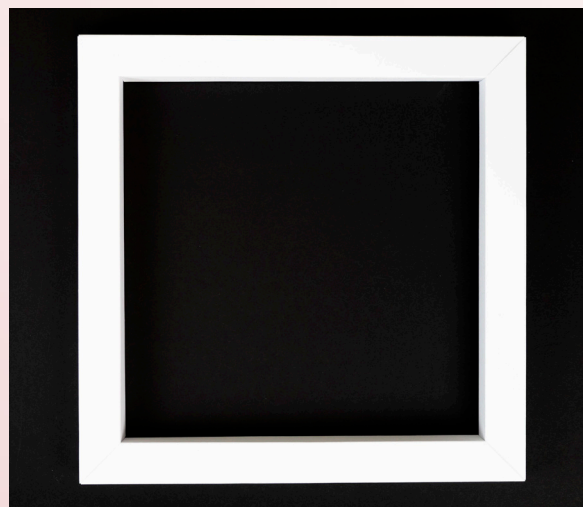
5. Take two of your frame sides. On one of the ends with a corner missing, apply wet glue all around the inside of this end. Using the other piece, slot a full end into the open end.



6. Push the piece in until it is snug with the other frame. Place an acrylic stamping block on the inside of the frame pieces to ensure you have a perfect right angle. Leave the pieces to dry.



7. Repeat Steps 6 & 7 for the next two frame pieces.



8. Attach the two joined pieces together in the same way you attach two single pieces together and leave to dry.

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
