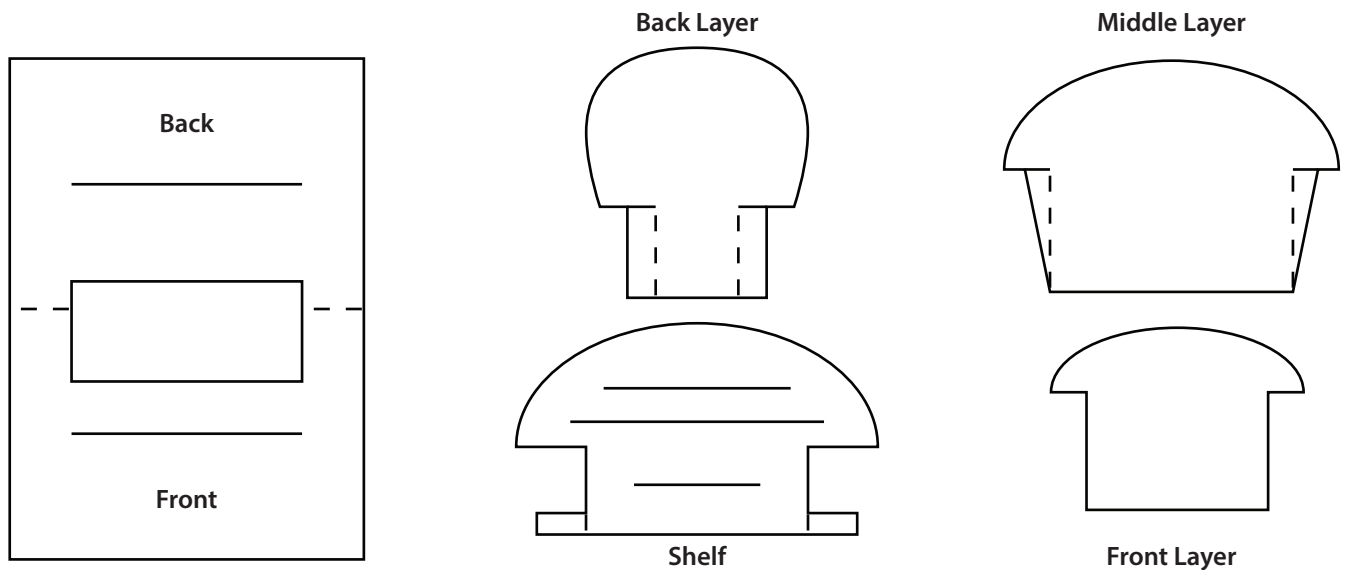


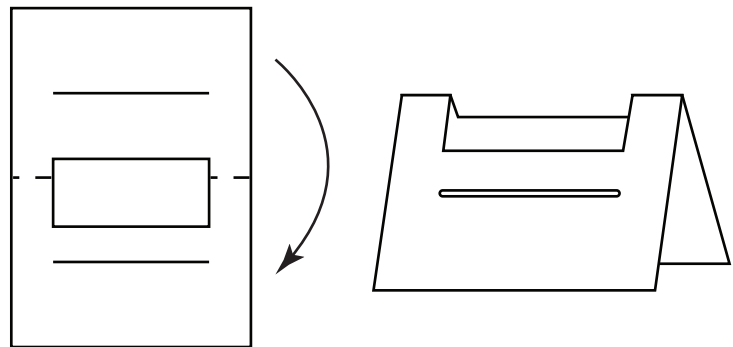


## SHELF CARD

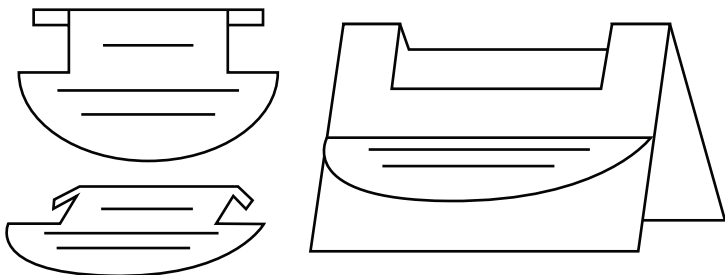
1. Cut out the template pieces and fold along the score lines.



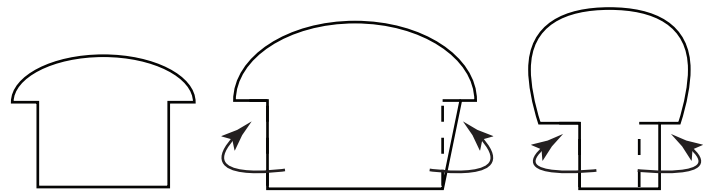
2. Fold the base card in half. Please note that where it is folded the gap is shallower on the back of the card than on the front of the card.



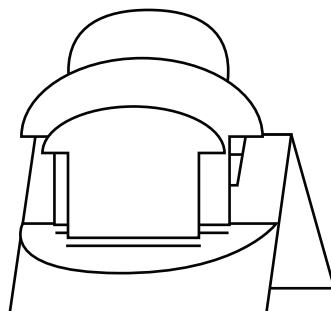
3. Fold down the tabs on the shelf piece and slide through the slots on base card. Unfold the tabs at the back of the card to secure.



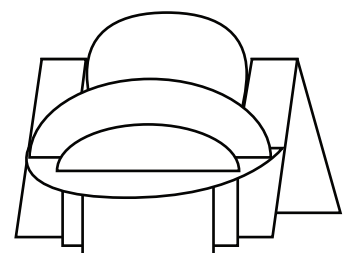
4. Make sure the end flap can open and close easily. Decorate as required.



5. Slide the front, middle and back layers into the slots on the shelf. On the middle and back, unfold the tabs and use them to support the shelf.



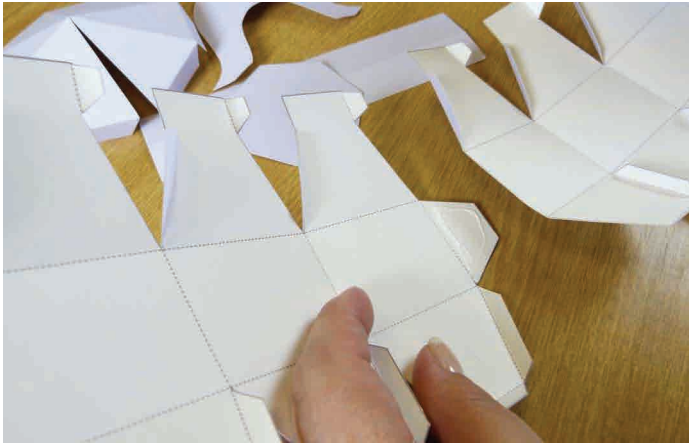
6. Your 3D Shelf Card is now ready to embellish.





## TEAPOT

1. Cut out the template pieces and fold along all the score lines. Apply glue to the end tab of Teapot Side 01 and stick to the straight side of Teapot Side 02.



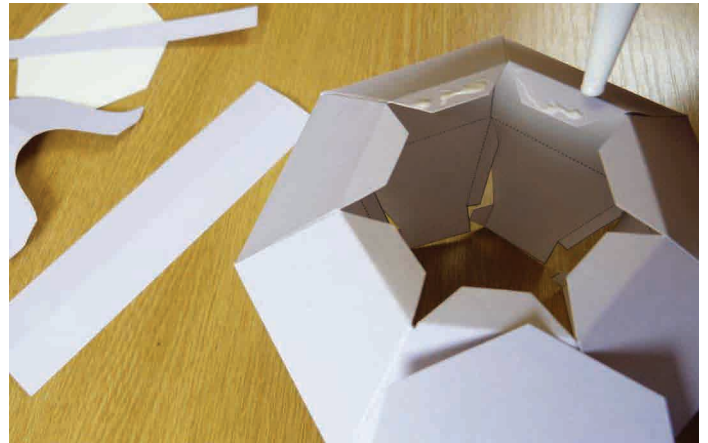
2. Glue the other tab to the other straight side to form the main section.



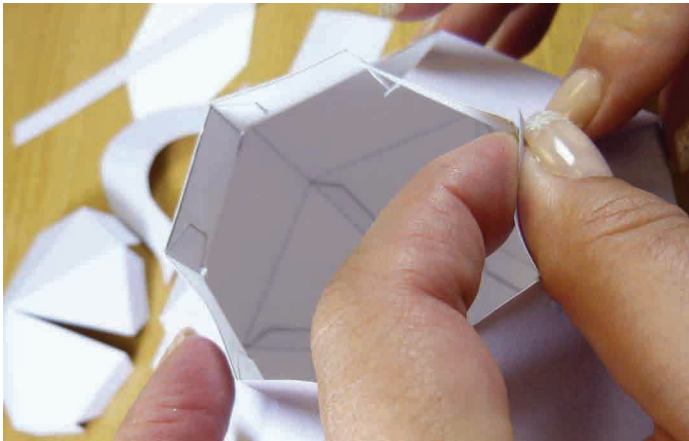
3. Apply glue to the bottom side tabs and stick together to form the bottom part of the teapot.



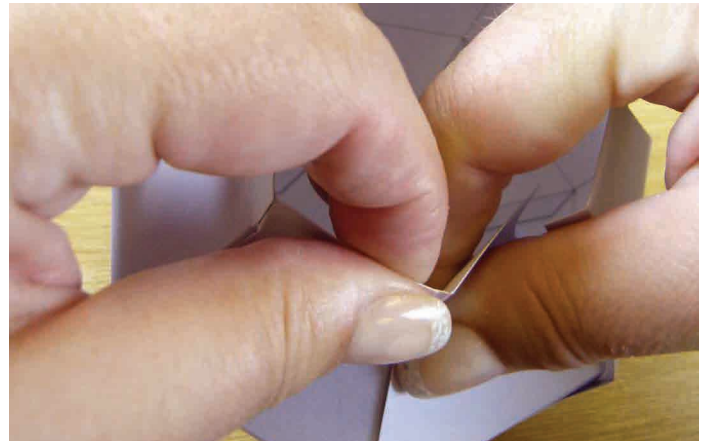
4. Apply glue to the bottom tabs and stick to the Teapot Base.



5. Apply glue to top side tabs and stick together to form the top part of the teapot.



6. Repeat with the top tabs on the teapot.





## TEAPOT CONT...

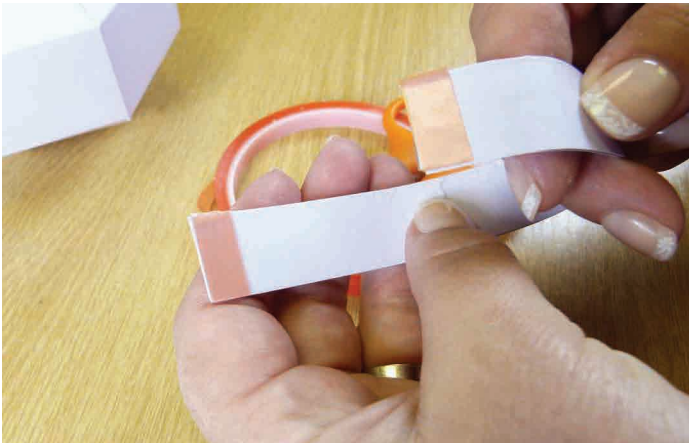
7. This forms the shape of your teapot.



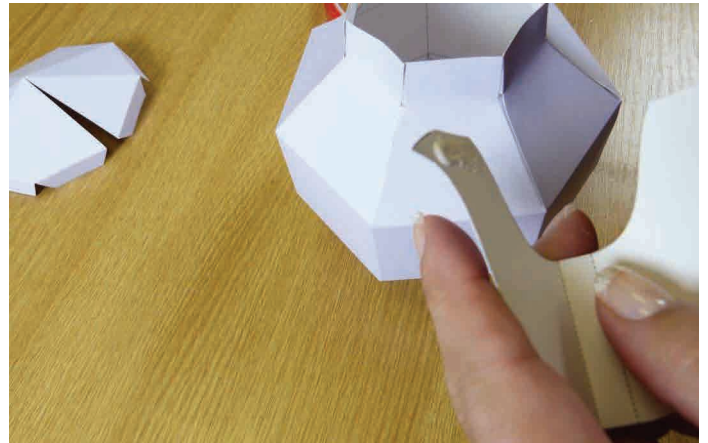
8. Fold the teapot handle piece in half and stick together.



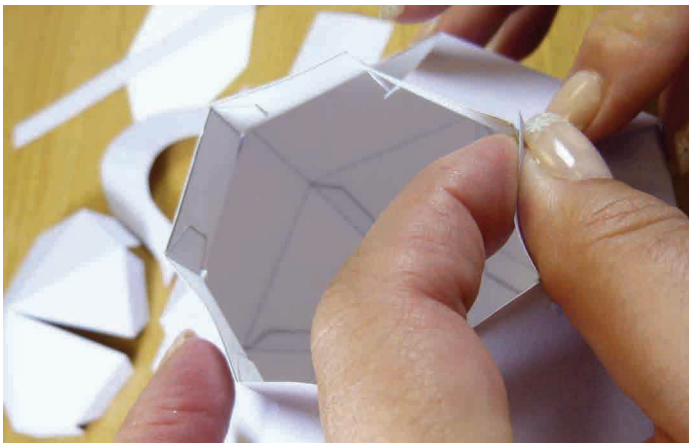
9. Gently shape to give a curve to the handle, apply tape to the top and bottom part of the handle and stick to a side of the teapot.



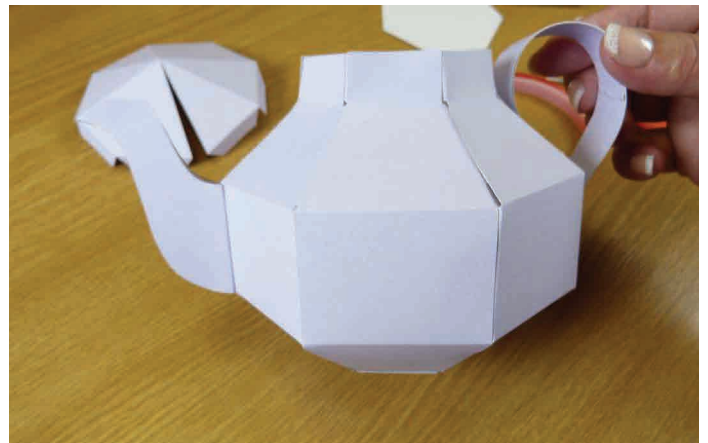
10. Fold the score lines on the spout piece and stick the the top of the spout together.



11. Stick the spout on to the teapot on the opposite side to your handle.



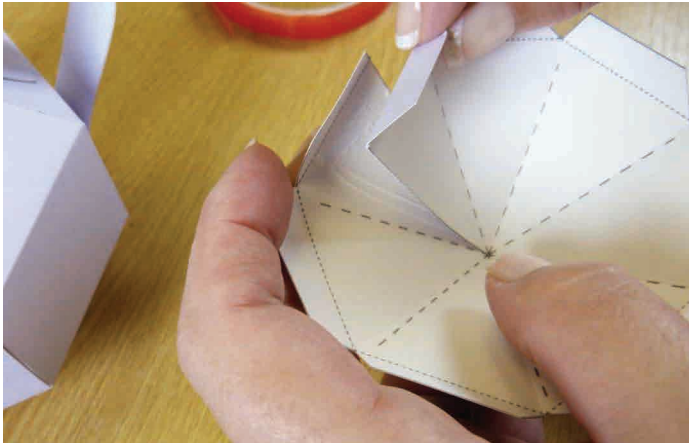
12. The teapot is built, now onto the lid.



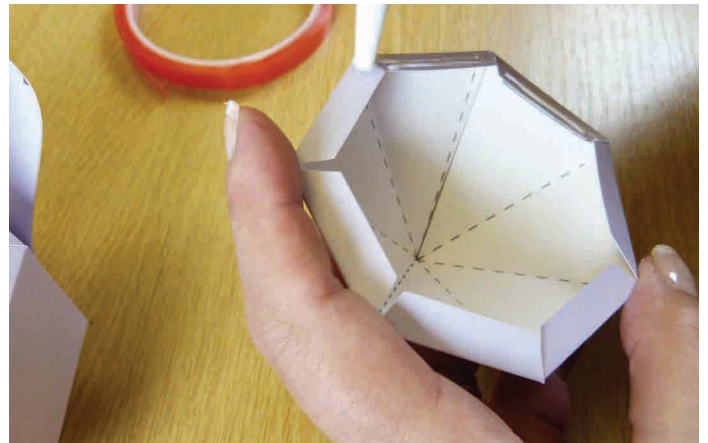


## TEAPOT CONT...

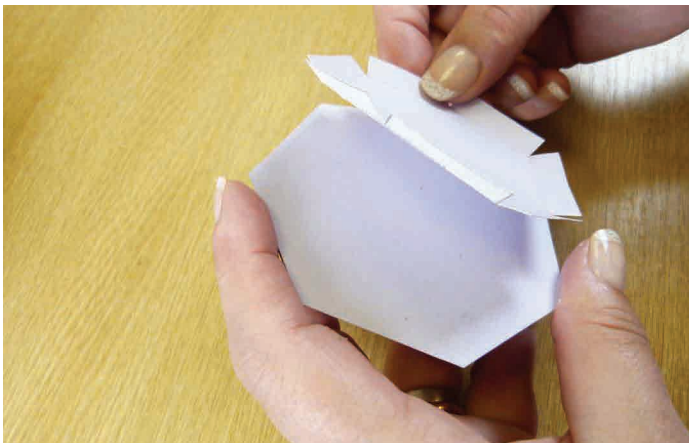
13. On the Teapot Lid piece, apply glue to one of the end triangles and overlay onto the other end triangle to start forming the shape.



14. Add glue to the tabs and stick to the Teapot Lid Base 01.



15. Glue Teapot Lid Base 02 underneath the lid and fold the tabs down.



16. Apply tab around the folded down tabs.



17. Wrap the Teapot Lid Base Wrap around the tabs.



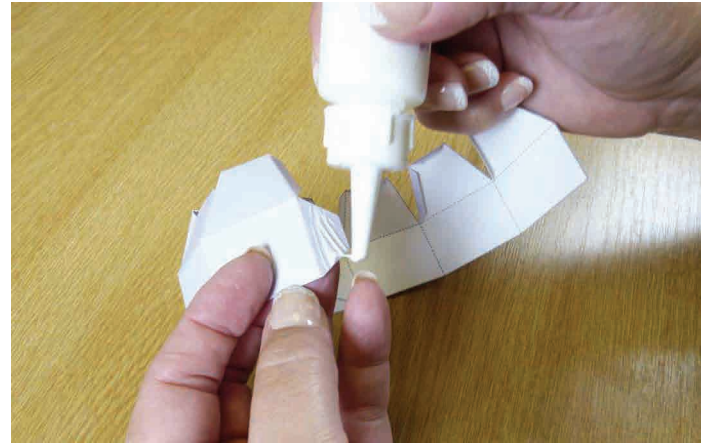
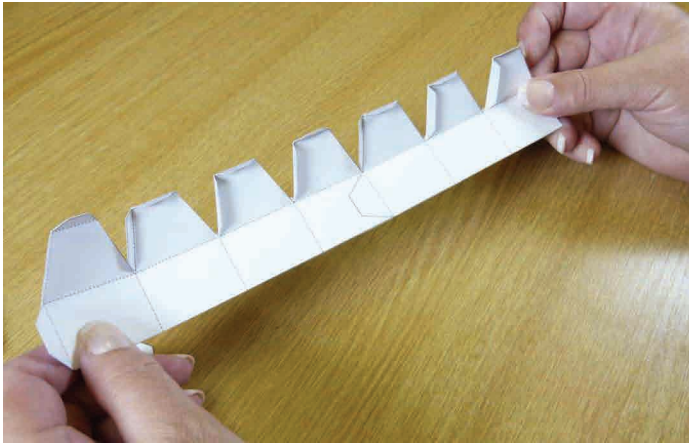
18. Place the lid on the teapot. This is now complete.



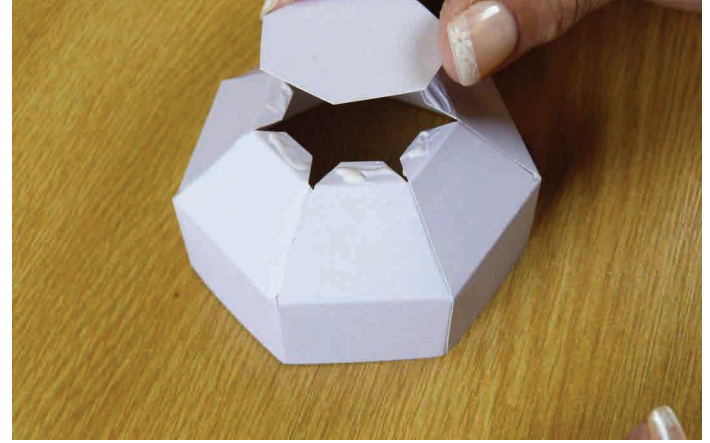


## TEACUP & SAUCER

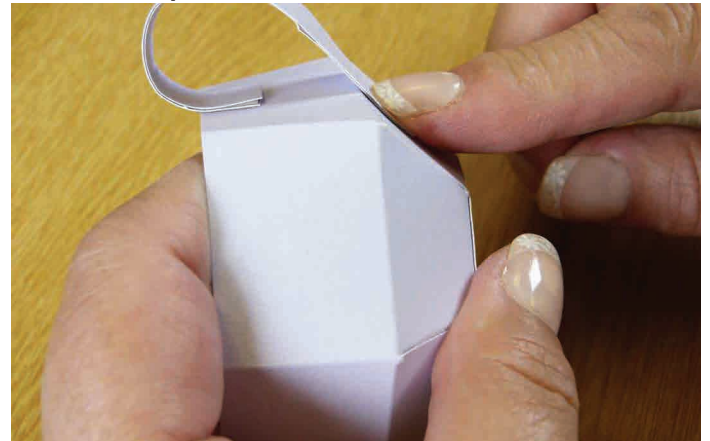
1. Cut out the template pieces and fold along all the score lines.
2. Apply glue to the tab on the end.



3. Stick to the straight edge side to form the main body of the cup.
4. Apply glue to the bottom tabs and stick to the Teacup Base piece.



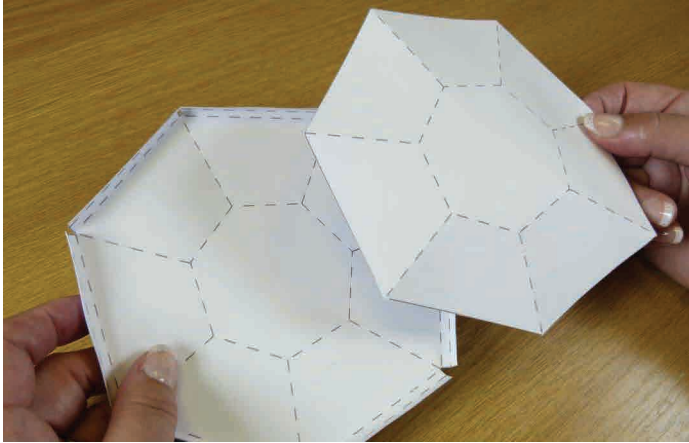
5. Fold the Teacup Handle in half and stick together.
6. Gently shape the handle to curve it. Apply tape or glue to the bottom and the top and stick to a side of the cup.



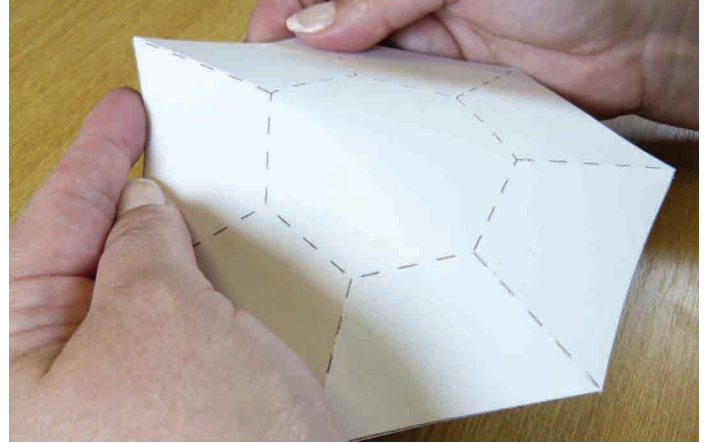


## TEACUP & SAUCER CONT...

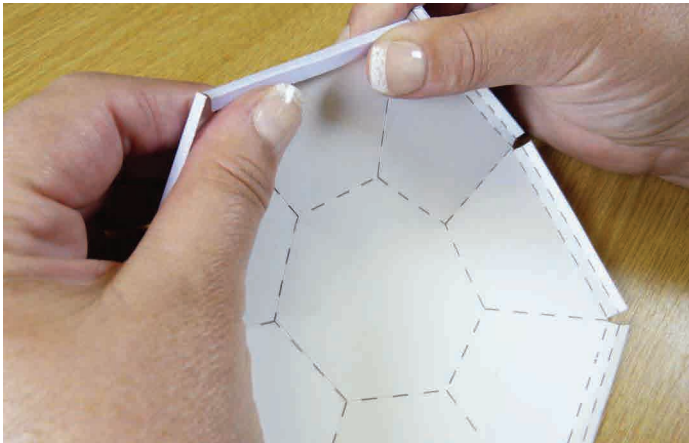
7. For the saucer, cut out the template pieces. If you are using the template version, draw round the whole template to create the saucer base, and just draw round the inner edge score line and cut to create the top.



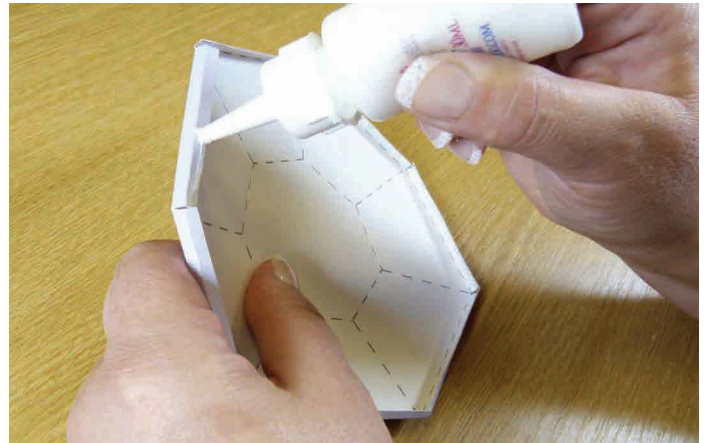
8. Gently tease all fold lines from the centre to the outer edge to give the saucer a little shape.



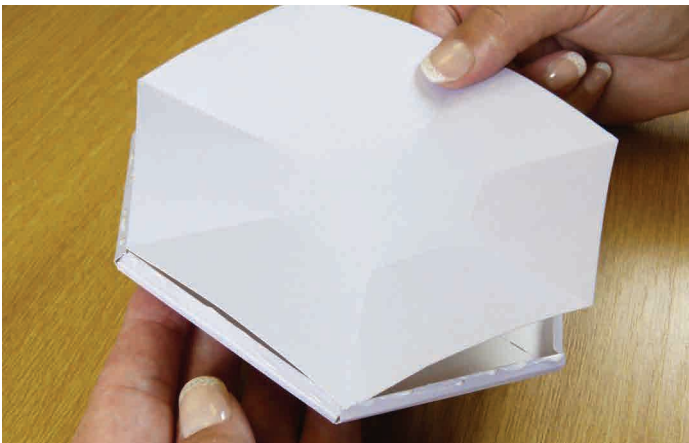
9. On the saucer base piece, fold the outer tabs into the centre.



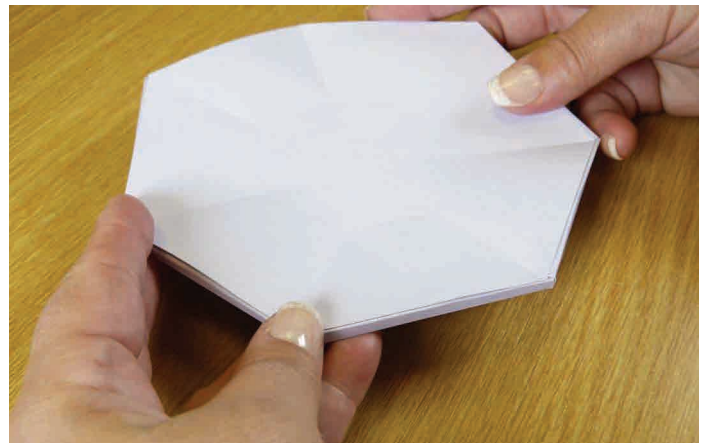
10. Apply glue to the outer tabs.



11. Stick the saucer top to the outer tabs.



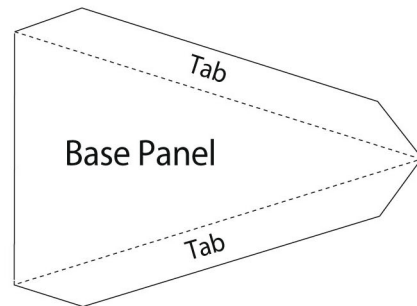
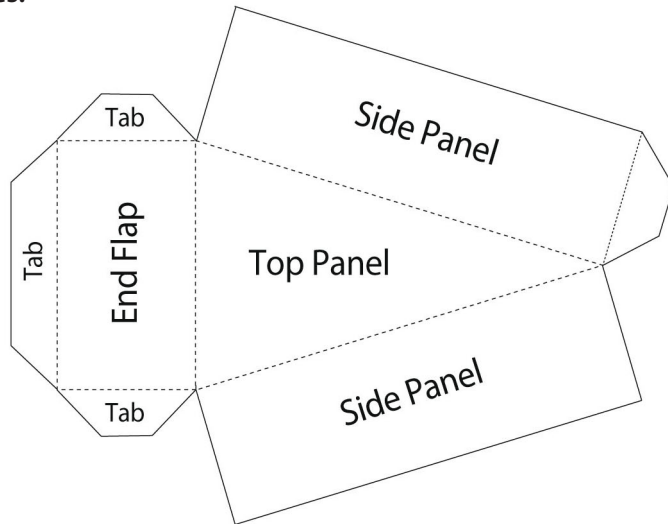
12. Gently tease the shape again. You now have a saucer.



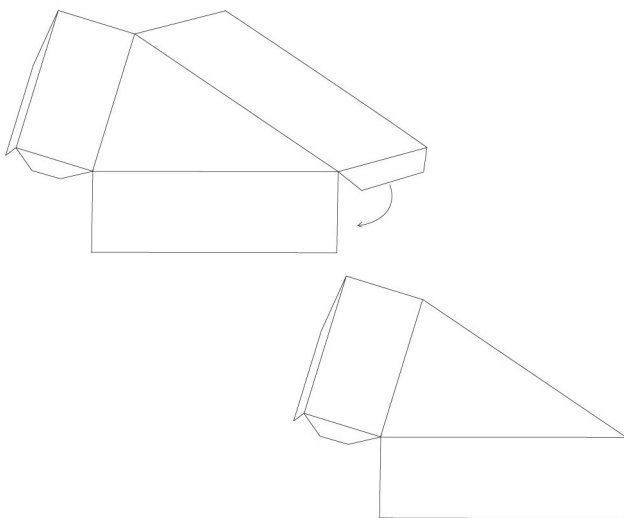


## CAKE

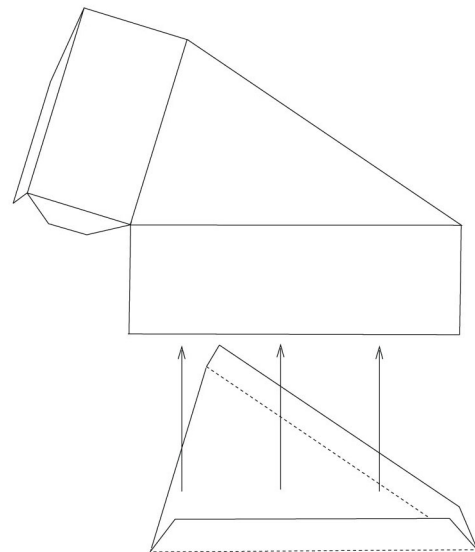
1. Cut out the template and fold along the score lines.



2. Make the top part of the box by folding down the side panels and securing with the tab at the point of the box.



3. Attach the base panel by securing the tabs to the inside of the side panel on the top of the box.



4. Make sure the end flap can open and close easily. Decorate as required.
