



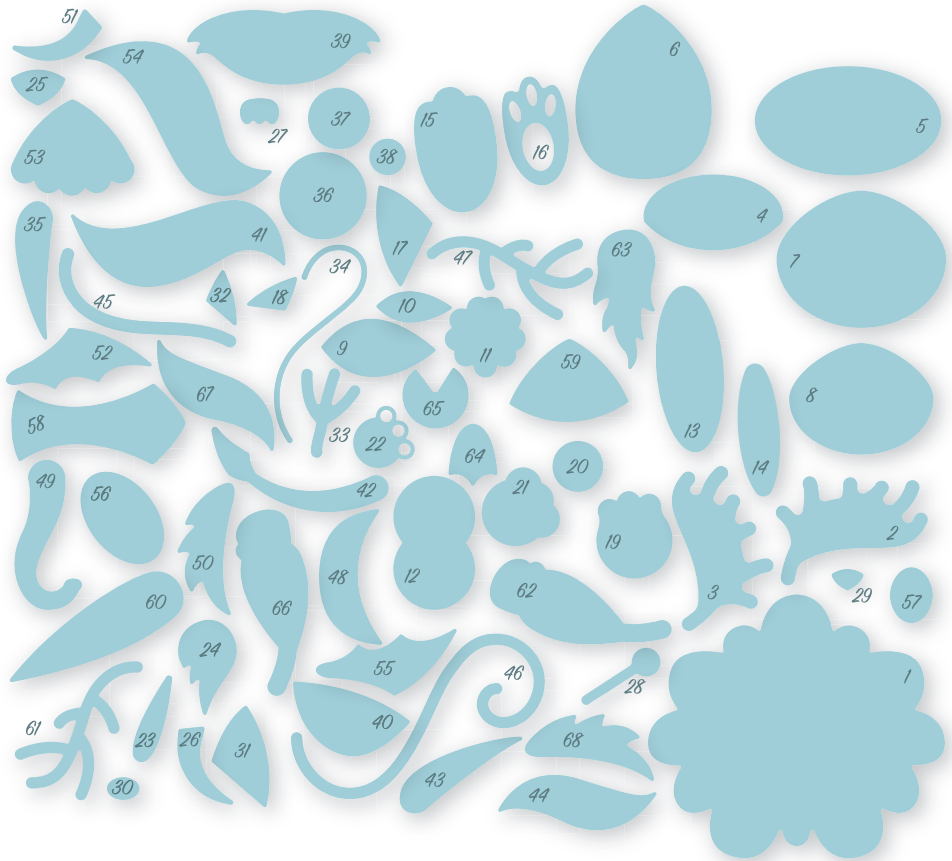

Charming Animals Die Key



Disclaimer:

The instructions included in this booklet refer to techniques and materials used for cardmaking. However you can use your material of choice whether it is appliqué, card, felt, faux leather etc.

Each die in the Charming Animals die set is listed with a number. In each project the "What you'll need" will specify what dies you will need to make each character and what part of the animal that die makes.

Bear

What you will need:

- No.6
- No.7
- No.30
- No.37
- No.38
- No.4
- No.35
- No.43
- No.56
- No.22
- White Cardstock
- Brown Cardstock
- Pink Cardstock



Cut No.7, No.37, No.6 and No.22 twice and No.4, No.35 and No.43 once from brown cardstock. Cut No.56 once from white cardstock, No.38 twice from pink cardstock and No.30 once from black cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat No.56 to the centre. Mat both No.22 die cuts to either side as shown.

To make the head:

To create the ears, mat the No.38 die cuts onto the centres of the No.37 die cuts. Mat behind No.7. Mat the No.4 die cut to No.7 and attach No.30 to the top centre as shown.

Using the No.43 and No.35 die cuts, mat one to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut, mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place.

Mat the body behind the head. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character as shown.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes and add faux stitching with a black pen.



Bee

What you will need:

- No.6
- No.7
- No.56
- No.59
- No.48
- No.28
- Yellow Cardstock
- Black Cardstock
- Grey Cardstock



Cut No.7 and No.6 twice from yellow cardstock. Cut No.56 twice from grey cardstock and finally cut No.28, No.59 and No.48 twice from black cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut, mat No.59 to the top and the No.48 die cut to the bottom as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, use both No.28 die cuts and mat these behind No.7 as shown.

Using the remaining No.48 and No.59 die cuts, mat these to the top and bottom of the back of the second No.6 die cut and mat this to the back of the body.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character as shown. Then attach both No.56 die cuts to the centre of the back to create a pair of wings.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes with a black pen.

Top Tip!

Try foiling the wings.



Cat

What you will need:

- No.6
- No.7
- No.65

- No.45
- No.39

- White Cardstock
- Black Cardstock
- Pink Cardstock



Cut No.6 and No.40 twice and No.7, No.6, No.31, No.17 and No.45 once from black cardstock. Cut No.56, No.35, No.32, No.18, No.7 and No.43 once and No.22 twice from white cardstock. Finally cut No.30 once from pink cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat No.56 to the centre. Mat both No.22 die cuts to either side as shown.

To make the head:

To create the ears, mat No.31 and No.32 together and No.17 and No.26 together. Stick these behind the white No.7 die cut. Mat both No.40 die cuts to either side of the white No.7. Mat the No.6 die cut to No.7 and attach No.30 to the top centre as shown.

Using the No.43 and No.35 die cuts, mat to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut and mat to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place. Attach No.45 to the bottom back of the body.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character.

Use a white pen to create the eyes and muzzle.

Chick

What you will need:

- No.6
- No.7
- No.25
- No.36
- No.53
- No.68
- No.50
- No.33
- Yellow Cardstock
- Orange Cardstock



Cut No.7, No.6 and No.53 twice and No.68 and No.50 once from yellow cardstock. Cut No.33 twice and No.25 once from orange cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat No.53 to the top. Mat both No.33 die cuts to either side as shown.

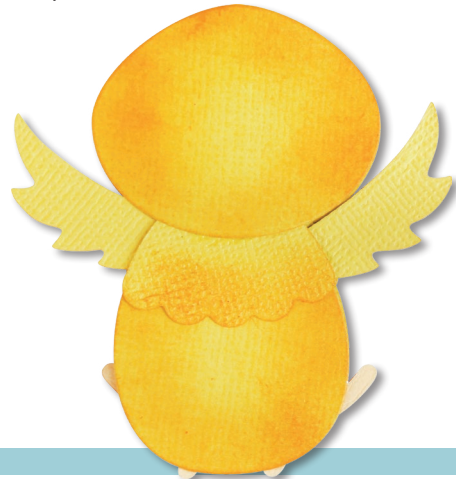
To make the head:

To create the head, mat No.25 to the centre of No.7.

Using the No.68 and No.50 die cuts, mat one either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut and mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the wings in place.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.53 die cut to the back of the body and then the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character as shown.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes with a black pen.



Cow

What you will need:

- No.7
- No.6
- No.51
- No.26
- No.65
- No.4
- No.43
- No.35
- No.57
- Tan Cardstock
- White Cardstock
- Pink Cardstock
- Silver Cardstock
- Black Cardstock



Cut No.7 and No.6 twice and No.43 and No.35 once from white cardstock. Cut No.65 twice from silver cardstock, No.57 six times from black cardstock, No.4 once from pink cardstock and finally No.26 and No.51 once from tan cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat three No.57 die cuts to the front.

To make the head:

Attach No.26 and No.51 behind No.7, stick No.4 to the bottom centre of the No.7 as shown. Mat both No.65 die cuts to either side as shown.

Using the No.43 and No.35 die cuts, stick these to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut. Mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character as shown.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes and add nostrils with a black pen.



Dog

What you will need:

- No.6
- No.7
- No.29
- No.31
- No.17
- No.50
- No.4
- No.35
- No.43
- No.56
- No.22
- No.37
- Brown Cardstock
- White Cardstock
- Black Cardstock



Cut No.7, No.6 and No.22 twice, No.50, No.35, No.31, No.17, No.4 and No.43 once from brown cardstock. Cut No.56 and No.41 once from white cardstock. Cut No.29 once from black cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat No.56 to the centre. Mat both No.22 die cuts to either side as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, use the No.17 and No.31 die cuts and mat these to the top either side of one No.7 die cut. Mat No.37 and No.4 die cuts onto No.7 and attach No.30 to the top centre as shown.

Using the No.43 and No.35 die cuts, stick these to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut. Then mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the No.50 die cut to the bottom centre and remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character as shown.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes and draw in the snout.



Dragon

What you will need:

- No.26
- No.51
- No.42
- No.4
- No.35
- No.43
- No.56
- No.22
- Green Cardstock
- Yellow Cardstock



Cut No.7, No.6 and No.22 twice and No.4, No.42, No.52, No.55, No.35 and No.43 once from green cardstock. Cut No.26, No.56 and No. 58 once from yellow cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat No.56 to the centre. Mat both No.22 die cuts to either side as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, use both No.26 and No.51 die cuts and stick these behind No.7. Mat the No.4 die cut to No.7 as shown.

Using the No.43 and No.35 die cuts, mat these to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut and mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place. Attach No.42 to the bottom back of the body and No.55 and No.52 to the top sides as shown.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character as shown.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes and draw in the nostrils.



Elephant

What you will need:

- No.6
- No.7
- No.49
- No.8
- No.35
- No.43
- No.19
- No.20
- Grey Cardstock
- Pink Cardstock



Cut No.7 four times, No.6 and No.19 twice and No.49, No.43 and No.35 once from grey cardstock. Cut No.8 and No.20 twice from pink cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut. Attach the No.20 die cuts to the centres of the No.19 die cuts and mat onto the body.

To make the head:

To create the head, mat the No.8 die cuts to the centres of two No.7 die cuts. Mat these behind one No.7 die cut. Attach the No.49 die cut to the centre as shown.

Using the No.35 and No.43 die cuts, mat these

to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut and mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes with a black pen.

Fox

- White Cardstock
- Orange Cardstock
- Pink Cardstock



Cut No.7, No.6 and No.22 twice and No.31, No.17, No.41, No.35 and No.43 once from orange cardstock. Cut No.32, No.39 and No. 51 once and No.32, No.18, No.41 and No.65 twice from white cardstock. Finally, cut No.30 once from pink cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat No.56 to the centre. Mat both the No.22 die cuts to either side as shown.

To make the head:

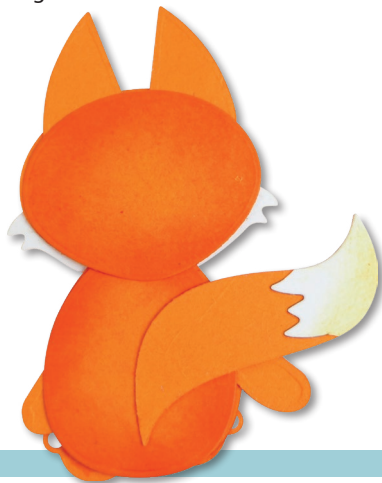
To create the ears, use the No.32 and No.18 die cuts and mat to the No.31 and No.17 die cuts. Mat these behind No.7. Mat the No.39 die cut to No.7 and attach No.30 to the top centre as shown.

Using the No.43 and No.35 die cuts, mat these to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut and mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place. Snip the white

No.41 die cuts to keep just the ends and attach to both sides of the remaining No.20 die cut, using the cut line as a guide. Attach No.41 to the bottom back of the body.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character as shown.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes with a black pen.



Frog

What you will need:

- No.6
- No.7
- No.5
- No.56
- No.43
- No.35
- No.64
- No.37
- Green Cardstock
- White Cardstock



Cut No.7, No.6, No.37 and No.64 twice and No.5, No.43 and No.35 once from green cardstock. Cut No.37 twice and No.56 once from white cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use the white No.6 die cut and mat No.56 to the centre. Mat both No.64 die cuts to either side as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, mat No.5 to the bottom of a No.7 die cut and attach two white No.37 die cuts to the top of either side as shown. Trim the two green No.41 die cuts and mat onto the eyes.

Using the No.35 and No.43 die cuts, mat these to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut and mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the body as shown.

Draw in eyes, nostril and a smile with a black pen.



Gorilla

What you will need:

- No.6
- No.8
- No.27
- No.7
- No.4
- No.62
- No.66
- No.22
- Brown Cardstock
- Grey Cardstock
- Draw-on eyes



Cut No.7 and No. 16 twice and No.62 and No.66 once from brown cardstock. Cut No.22 twice and No.8, No.4, No.66 and No.62 once from grey cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat No.22 die cuts to either side as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, mat the No.4 die cut to the bottom of No.8 and attach to the centre of No.7 as shown.

Using the grey No.66 and No.62 die cuts snip from the wrists leaving the hand and mat these to the corresponding brown No.66 and No.62 die cuts. Attach both arms to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut and mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character as shown.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes with a black pen.



Lamb

What you will need:

- No.7
- No.1
- No.20
- No.11
- No.65
- White Cardstock
- Grey Cardstock
- Black Cardstock



Cut No.1 four times and No.11 once from white cardstock. Cut No.65 twice from black cardstock and No.7 and No.20 twice from grey cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.1 die cut and mat both No.65 die cuts to either side as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, use both No.20 die cuts and mat these behind No.7. Mat the head to the centre of one of the No.1 die cuts. Mat No.11 onto the top centre of the No.7 between the ears as shown.

Using the second No.1 die cut mat this to the back of the body.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.1 die cut to the back of the character.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes and draw in the snout with a black pen.

Lion

What you will need:

- No.6

- No.65
- No.37
- No.38
- No.45
- No.39
- No.35
- No.43
- No.56
- No.22
- Orange Cardstock
- Tan Cardstock
- Pink Cardstock



Cut No.39, No.7, No.35, No.43 and No.45 once and cut No.6, No.22 and No.37 twice from tan cardstock. Cut No.56 once and No.1 twice from orange cardstock. Finally cut No.38 twice and No.30 once from pink cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat No.56 to the centre. Mat both No.22 die cuts to either side as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, use both No.38 die cuts and mat to the No.37 die cuts. Stick these behind No.7. Mat the No.39 die cut to No.7 and attach No.30 to the top centre as shown. Mat the head to the centre of one of the No.1 die cuts.

Using the No.35 and No.43 die cuts, mat these to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut and mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place. Attach No.45 to the bottom back of the body.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.1 die cut to the back of the character.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes and draw in the snout with a black pen.

Monkey

What you will need:

- No.66
- No.22
- Brown Cardstock
- Pink Cardstock



Cut No.7 and No.6 twice and No.62, No.66 and No.46 once from brown cardstock. Cut No.22 and No.37 twice and No.8 and No.33 once from pink cardstock.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character as shown.

To make the body:

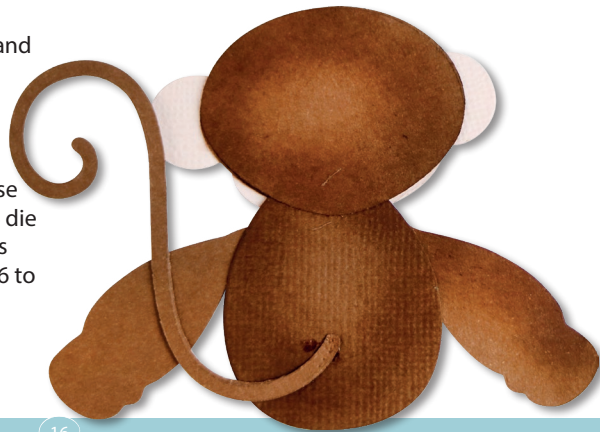
To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat the No.22 die cuts to either side as shown.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes and draw in the nostrils with a black pen.

To make the head:

To create the head, use both No.37 die cuts and mat these behind No.8. Mat the No.4 die cut to the bottom of No.8 and attach to the centre of No.7 as shown.

Using the No.66 and No.62 die cuts, mat these to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut and mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place. Attach No.46 to the bottom back of the body.

Cut No.7, No.9 and No.6 twice and No.4, No.43 and No.35 once from brown cardstock. Cut No.2 and No.3 twice from tan cardstock. Cut No.65 twice and No.29 once from black cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat both No.65 die cuts to either side as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, use both No.9 die cuts, stick these behind No.7 and attach No.3 and No.2 in between them. Mat No.4 to the bottom centre of the No.7 and mat No.29 to the top centre as shown.

Using the No.43 and No.35 die cuts, stick these to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut. Glue this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character as shown.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes with a black pen.



Mouse

What you will need:

- No.6
- No.7
- No.29
- No.36

- No.34
- No.66
- No.22
- Grey Cardstock
- Pink Cardstock



Cut No.7, No.6 and No.36 twice and No.34 once from grey cardstock. Cut No.27 four times, No.37 twice and No.29 once from pink cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut, mat No.56 to the centre and mat the No.27 die cuts to either side top and bottom as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, use both No.37 die cuts, mat to the centre of No.36 and mat these behind No.7. Mat the No.29 die cut to the centre of No.7 as shown.

Using the second No.6 die cut, mat this to the back of the body. Attach No.34 to the bottom back of the body.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character as shown.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes, whiskers and a snout with a black and white pen.



Otter

What you will need:

- No.6

- No.65
- No.35
- No.38
- No.39
- No.27
- No.56
- No.22
- Brown Cardstock
- Tan Cardstock
- Black Cardstock



Cut No.7 and No.6 twice and No.39 and No.35 once from brown cardstock. Cut No.56 once from tan cardstock and cut No.27, No.22 and No.38 twice and No.30 once from black cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat No.56 to the centre. Attach both No.27 die cuts to the top sides of the No.6. Mat both No.22 die cuts to either side as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, use both No.38 die cuts and mat these behind No.7 so they are just showing. Mat the No.39 die cut to No.7 and attach No.30 to the top centre as shown.

Using the No.35 die cut mat this to the bottom back of the last No.6 die cut, point side outwards. Attach this piece to the back of the body section as shown.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes and add a smile and freckles with a black pen.



Owl

What you will need:

- No.6
- No.7
- No.25
- No.53
- No.68
- No.50
- No.33
- No.12
- Brown Cardstock
- Yellow Cardstock
- White Cardstock
- Tan Cardstock
- Black Cardstock



Cut No.7, No.6 and No.53 twice and No.68 and No.50 once from brown cardstock. Cut No.33 twice from yellow cardstock. Cut No.25 once from tan cardstock and cut No.12 once from white and black cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat No.53 to the top. Mat both No.33 die cuts to either side as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, mat the black No.12 behind the white No.12 to create a slight shadow effect as shown. Mat No.12 to the centre of one No.7 then attach the No.25 die cut to the bottom centre of No.12 as shown.

Using the No.68 and No.50 die cuts, mat these to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut and mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.53 die cut to the back of the body and then the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character as shown.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes with a black pen.



Panda

What you will need:

- No.56
- No.22
- No.57
- White Cardstock
- Black Cardstock
- Pink Cardstock



Cut No.7 and No.6 twice and No.4 once from white cardstock. Cut No.22, No.37 and No.57 twice and No.30, No.35 and No.43 once from black cardstock. Finally cut No.38 twice and No.56 once from pink cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat both No.22 die cuts to either side as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, use both No.38 die cuts and mat to the centre of both No.37 die cuts. Stick these behind No.7. Attach both No.57 die cuts behind No.4, then mat the No.4 die cut to No.7 and attach No.30 to the top centre as shown.

Using the No.43 and No.35 die cuts, mat these

to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut and mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character.

Draw in the eyes with a white pen and the snout with a black pen.

Penguin

What you will need:

- No.6
- No.7
- No.25
- No.8
- No.58
- No.35
- No.43
- No.64
- Black Cardstock
- Orange Cardstock
- White Cardstock



Cut No.58 once from white cardstock. Cut No.43, No.35 and No.6 once from black cardstock. Cut No.64 twice and No.25 once from orange cardstock. Cut No.7 twice from black cardstock. Cut No.25 once from orange cardstock and cut No.8 once from white cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use the black No.6 die cut and mat No.58 to the top. Mat both No.64 die cuts to either side as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, trim a V shape into the top of the No.8 die cut from white and mat onto the centre of No.7 die cut as shown.

Using the No.35 and the No.43 die cuts, mat these point side out to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut and mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place.

Mat the head onto the top front of the body. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character.

Use the Draw-on eyes to bring your character to life.

What you will need:

- Silver cardstock
- Light Brown cardstock



Cut No. 34 twice and No.7, No.4, No.35 and No.43 once from light brown cardstock. Cut No.56 once from brown cardstock. Cut No.10 twice and cut No.24, No.63, No.44 and No.67 once from brown cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat the No.56 die cut to the centre. Attach the No.20 die cuts to either side of the No.6 die cut as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, mat the No.10 die cuts to the back of one No.7 die cut. Mat the No.4 die cut to the bottom centre as shown. Then mat the No.24 die cut to the top front between the ears. Using the No.35 and No.43 die cuts, mat these to either side of the front of the second No.6 die

cut and mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character. Mat No.44 and No.67 together, mat the die cut to the bottom and the No.63 die cut to the top back, being careful to line it up with the mane die cut on the front.

Use the Draw-on eyes to bring your character to life and draw in the nostrils with a black pen.

Cut No.7, No.13, No.6, No.27, No.15 twice and No.39 and No.38 once from white cardstock. Cut No.14 twice and No.29 and No.56 once from pink cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat No.56 to the centre. Attach both No.27 die cuts to the top sides of No.6. Mat both No.15 die cuts to either side as shown. Attach the No.16 die cuts to the centres of the No.15 die cuts.

To make the head:

To create the head, use both No.14 die cuts and mat to the No.13 die cuts. Stick these behind No.7. Mat the No.39 die cut to No.7 and attach No.29 to the top centre as shown.

Using the No.38 die cut, mat this to the bottom

back of the last No.6 die cut. Attach this piece to the back of the body section.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes, the snout and the teeth with black pen.

- Brown Cardstock
- Black Cardstock
- Red Cardstock



Cut No.7, No.9 and No.6 twice and No.4, No.49 and No.35 once from tan cardstock. Cut No.65 twice from black cardstock and No.29 once from red cardstock. Cut No.61 and No.47 once from brown cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat both No.65 die cuts to either side as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, use both No.9 die cuts and stick these behind No.7, attach No.47 and No.61 in between them. Mat No.4 to the bottom centre of No.7 and mat No.29 to the top centre of that as shown.

Using the No.43 and No.35 die cuts, mat these to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut. Mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character as shown.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes with a black pen.



Rhino

What you will need:

- No.6
- No.7
- No.10
- No.26
- No.5
- No.35
- No.43
- No.56
- No.19
- No.20
- Grey cardstock
- Tan Cardstock
- Light Grey Cardstock



Cut No.7, No.10, No. 16 and No.19 twice and No.5, No.35 and No.43 once from grey cardstock. Cut No. 51 once and No.20 twice from light grey cardstock and cut No.26 once from tan cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat No.56 to the centre. Mat both No.19 die cuts to either side and then mat both of the No.20 die cuts to the centres of No.19 as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, use both No.10 die cuts. Mat these behind No.7. Mat the No.5 die cut to No.7 and attach No.26 to the centre as shown.

Using the No.43 and No.35 die cuts, mat these to either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut and mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place.

Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character as shown.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes and a smile with a black and white pen.



Unicorn

What you will need:

- No.6
- No.7
- No.10
- No.44
- No.67
- No.4
- No.35
- No.43
- No.56
- No.20
- No.24
- No.63
- No.23
- Lilac Cardstock
- Pink Cardstock
- Grey cardstock
- Purple cardstock

Cut No.7, No.10, No.6 and No.20 twice and No.4, No.35 and No.43 once from lilac cardstock. Cut No.56 once from pink cardstock. Cut No.23 once and No.19 twice from grey cardstock and cut No.24, No.44, No.63 and No.67 once from purple cardstock.

To make the body:

To create the body, use one No.6 die cut and mat the No.56 die cut to the centre. Attach the No.20 die cuts to either side of No.6 as shown.

To make the head:

To create the head, mat the No.10 die cuts to the back of one No.7 die cut. Mat the No.4 die cut to the bottom centre as shown. Mat the No.24 die cut to the top front between the ears. Attach No.23 to the centre of the No.24 piece as shown.

Using the No.35 and No.43 die cuts, mat onto either side of the front of the second No.6 die cut and mat this to the back of the body. This will sandwich the arms in place.



Apply glue to the top front of the body and mat the head onto this. Flip the character over and mat the remaining No.7 die cut to the back of the character as shown. Glue the No.44 and No.67 together, mat the die cut to the bottom and the No.63 die cut to the top back. Be careful to line it up with the mane die cut on the front.

To bring your character to life, draw the eyes and the nostrils with a black pen.

Top Tip!

Try using cold foiling on the mane, tail, and horn.
