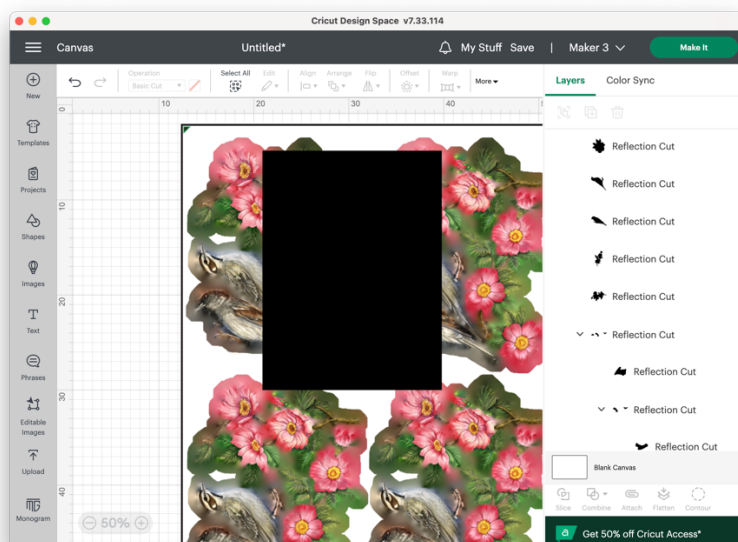


Using SVG Files & Reflections On a Cricut Machine

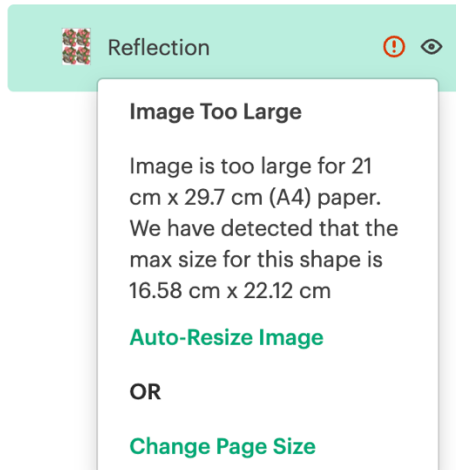
These step-by-step instructions walk you through how to cut reflections using their SVG files on your Cricut electronic cutting machine.

These steps have been created using Cricut Design Space software and the Cricut Maker 3. Your machine needs to support the Print and Cut function.

1. For ease, take a copy of the PDF Reflection artwork and the matching SVG file to your desktop or somewhere convenient.
2. Convert the PDF reflection into a JPEG image. Several online services are available to do this, or you can install software to your computer to do this. Online options we've used include:

3. Open Cricut Design Space and using the Upload option on left, upload the newly converted JPEG image:
 - Choose Complex image type, click Continue.
 - Use the Crop option to crop the image down to just outside the black outline. Then click Apply & Continue.
 - Choose Print Then Cut Image, name your uploaded image and click Upload.
4. Again using the Upload option, upload the matching Reflection Cut SVG file.
5. Once uploaded, select both files in Design Space and click Add to Canvas. When first added, the SVG file will show as solid black and the JPEG image will be much larger:

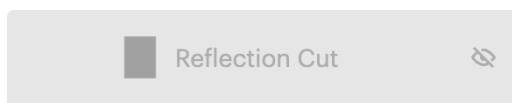


6. Select the reflection image and scale this down – if printing on an A4 sheet, the largest size this can be is 16.58cm x 22.12cm. You can automatically resize to this by clicking the red exclamation mark next to the Reflection layer on the right-hand side of the screen:



7. Make sure the SVG file is in front of the image by right-clicking the black rectangle and choosing Bring to Front. Then move and resize this to fit the black rectangle on the reflection image.
8. On the layers panel on the right-hand side of the screen, use the eye next to the first reflection cut layer (the black rectangle) to hide this, and you should now see the individual elements lined up with the reflection:

▼ ■ Reflection Cut

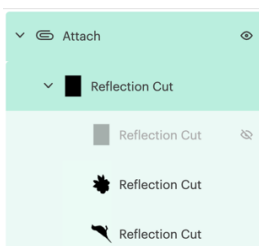


✿ Reflection Cut

9. Next, click the Reflection Cut group at the top of the layers panel, right-click and choose Attach.



- 10.** Select the SVG image on the canvas, right-click and choose Send to Back to bring the reflection image to the front. Make sure not to move anything at this stage.
- 11.** Click Make It in the top-right corner, select On Mat when prompted, select your mat size and click Confirm.
- 12.** Ensure the material size is set correctly for your print, then click Continue and print your reflection.
- 13.** Once printed, the artwork will have an L shape in each corner, which is what the machine uses to register where the image is.
- 14.** Load your mat into your machine with the printed reflection attached – the machine will read the marks and cut out your image.
